

## **CRITERIA FOR ACCEPTANCE**

- ⇒ Commitment to a career in coaching or sport leadership
- ⇒ University undergraduate degree in Physical Education is preferred however the equivalent coaching related training, education and/or experience and demonstration of coaching competency will be considered in lieu
- ⇒ Four or more years experience coaching a training group of athletes in a year-round program (training group to be at a intermediate or advanced level of competition)
- ⇒ A letter of endorsement from your national sport federation

## **APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

**If you are applying for the National Coaching Institute – Calgary, please attach the following information to your IOC Olympic Solidarity Olympic Scholarship Application.**

1. A one-page letter of intent outlining why you want to attend the NCI and what your future plans or goals are in sport – as a coach, administrator or other leadership role.
2. A resume of coaching experience and achievements, including the age, level and events of the athletes you have coached, and their highest competitive achievements.
3. A letter of endorsement from your national sport federation indicating their support for your enrolment in the NCI-Calgary Diploma high performance coaching education program.
4. A copy of your academic transcript or describe your equivalent training, education and/or experience that helped prepare you as an advanced coach.

## **TUITION FEES**

Tuition fees for international students (non-Canadian residents) are \$5,000.US per semester. Fall semester runs September to December and winter semester runs January through April each year.
